This course prepares the student by providing the knowledge and leadership skills to function as an Ambulance Strike Team Leader (ASTL). At the completion of the class, the student will be ready to begin the credentialing process with their LEMSA and EMSA. The student will also be qualified to deploy as an ASTL trainee on deployments or training events under the guidance of an accredited ASTL.
