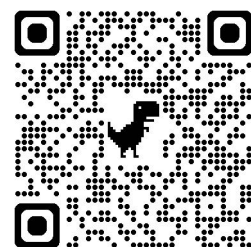

Salary and Hours- Full-Time Firefighter/ Paramedic: Annual Salary \$101,940.00-\$115,332.00 (upon successful completion of Driver Operator series).

Truckee Fire operates on a 48/96 schedule and these new positions will cross-staff ambulance and fire apparatus throughout the District. Shift assignments are subject to change throughout the course of a one-year probationary period.

Position Summary: Under general supervision, a Firefighter/Paramedic will engage in firefighter and rescue activities for the preservation of life, property, and environment; administers pre-hospital care within the scope of practice set forth by SSV LEMSA, and respond to various emergencies involving public safety and medical care. The Firefighter will be required to work 48-hour shifts, including weekends and holidays. Firefighter/Paramedics will be expected to learn and perform the full range of fire suppression, safety and rescue duties as outlined by guideline, policy or as directed by superior ranks in a dynamic environment. Truckee Fire Protection District is looking for candidates who are highly motivated, hardworking, honest, forward thinking problem solvers who thrive working in team environments.

Minimum Qualifications: The ideal candidate will possess the following:

Be at least 18 years of age by the closing date of the recruitment period

- Be in possession of a high school diploma or a General Equivalency Diploma (GED)
- Be a U.S. Citizen or have proof of legal right to work in the U.S.
- Have and maintain a valid drivers license
- Have and maintain a state of California Paramedic License
- Obtain SSV LEMSA accreditation within 6 months of employment
- Be able to pass a pre-employment physical performed by a physician, including drug testing
- Have completed an accredited California academy, or possess a California FFI, or IFSAC/ ProBoard FFI.
- AHA CPR Certification
- Current CPAT or ability to obtain prior to final interview (Entry Level ONLY – not required for lateral applicants)

About the Department:

The Truckee Fire Protection District is an "All Risk" District founded in 1894; we will respond to the needs of the community, regardless of the nature of the incident, and begin the process of solving the problem to lead to a positive outcome. The District is comprised of specialists in the areas of Structural Firefighting, Vehicle Extrication, Confined Space Rescue, Airport Rescue Firefighting, Backcountry (summer and winter) Rescue, High Angle Rescue, Swift Water, Ice Rescue, and Wildland Firefighting. Truckee Fire Protection District has a service area of 125 square miles located centrally in the northern Sierra Nevada mountains exposing employees to extreme weather including deep snow and frigid temperatures. The Fire District includes an airport, the I-80 freeway, the Truckee River, multiple lakes, and a hospital. Last year the District responded to roughly 4,000 calls for service with call volume consistently trending upward every year.
